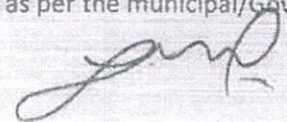

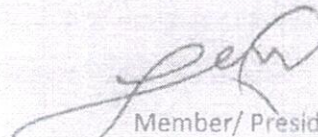

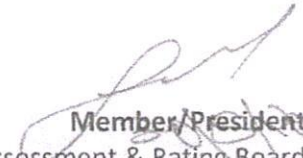

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to convey the approval of Medical Assessment & Rating Board (MARB) for renewal of permission for admission of 2nd batch (1st renewal) against the annual intake of 100 MBBS seats at Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Osmanabad under "The Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik" u/s 26 (1)(a)(b) and 28(1)(2) of the NMC Act, 2019 for the academic year 2023-24.

2. The MARB has granted approval on the basis of the assessment report dated 27.02.2023 and physical compliance verification report dated 29.05.2023 relating to availability of necessary infrastructure and teaching faculties in the College along with the requisite fee to the National Medical Commission.

5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of the Medical Assessment & Rating Board of the NMC and the State Govt.

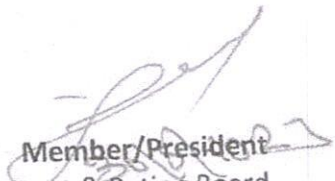

Subject: Assessment of Annual Declaration Form and grant of Renewal of Undergraduate seats (MBBS) for the year 2024-25 - regarding.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to convey that all medical colleges/Institutes having valid Letter of Permission (LoP) for MBBS admission are required to fill the details/data of respective Institutions on NMC portal for Annual Declaration as required in the NMC Act, 2019 and various regulations. Accordingly, through Public notices, all colleges/Institutions were directed to submit the details on the portal. Details submitted by your college have been assessed by the experts and accordingly your college was issued a show cause notice containing the details of deficiencies observed by the experts while evaluating the annual declaration form, video of examination, SAF-C provided by your college along with the AEBAS report.

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2. Vide the above show cause notice issued to your college, it was directed to furnish the reply regarding each of the points raised in the show cause notice within three days (3 days) and give an explanation as to why the seats allocated to your institution for MBBS not be reduced in A-Y 2024-25, or should a monetary penalty as per the regulations not be imposed since your college has not fulfilled the provisions laid down under NMC Act 2019 and other various guidelines, regulation notified by NMC. Here, it is pertinent to reiterate that all the medical colleges were earlier continuously intimated in the form of circulars/public notices uploaded through NMC website and show cause notices stating to take necessary action to fulfill the provisions laid in various regulations and guidelines by NMC. Further, vide above show cause notice issued, your medical colleges were given an additional opportunity to submit the point-wise explanation on the observations, if any, through the virtual hearing before the Undergraduate Medical Education Board.

3. In the above virtual hearing, your college was represented by the Dean/Principal/Vice-Principal/HoD, who appeared before the Board on **22/05/2024**. However, the clarifications furnished by your institution were not found convincing and satisfactory. The college also accepted the deficiencies and assured to fulfill the same within a very short span of time.

4. Since the portal for submission of Annual Declaration Form has been introduced first time, taking a lenient view the **Board decided to grant renewal of 100 seats for undergraduate (MBBS) for the year 2024-25 subject to deposit of a fine of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs only)** as a first measure; subsequently, after a gap of two months, the re-assessment of your college will be carried out. If deficiencies exist with your college, stringent action as mandated under MSMER-2023 Chapter-III clause-8 under the heading penalties shall be imposed.

5. As per, it is directed to remit the penalty amount within seven days (7 days) into **"NMC Own Resources, Canara Bank Account No. 90682160000025, IFSC code CNRB0019109"** and forward confirmation of payment along with transaction details to ug.scn@nmc.org.in.

6. If you are not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the Board, you are free to prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within sixty days of the issue of this letter.

Subject: Renewal of Undergraduate Seats (MBBS) of Government Medical College and Hospital, Osmanabad, Maharashtra for the year AY- 2025-26 - regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Public Notice issued by UGMEB vide dated 01.11.2024 uploaded on the NMC website on 06.11.2024, directing all medical colleges with valid Letters of Permission (LoP) to upload the details/data of their respective institutions on the NMC portal for the annual declaration, as required under the NMC Act, 2019 and various regulations issued by NMC from time to time, for the grant of renewal of MBBS seats for the academic year 2025-26.

2. Based on the details furnished by your college, the experts assessed the submissions, and accordingly, a Show Cause Notice dated **06.05.2025** was issued highlighting the following deficiencies observed during the assessment:

- i. All the departments are deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data.
- ii. Cadavers are inadequate.
- iii. In Clinical investigation, Histopathology, Cytopathology & Clinical Pathology are inadequate.
- iv. MRI facility not available.
- v. Number of Major/Minor OT's not available.
- vi. Total number of birth's much more then the bed occupancy rate of the Hospital, needs clarification.

3. Subsequently, the compliance report submitted by your Institution was also evaluated by the Assessors; however, amongst

other deficiencies, following key deficiencies were again highlighted w.r.t. your College/Institution:

- i. All the departments are still deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data.
- ii. Cadavers data still inadequate.
- iii. MRI facility still deficient.

Further, it has been observed that during the renewal process for the previous year AY 2024-25, penalty was imposed and conditional renewal was granted in view of the substantive nature of deficiencies in your College.

4. The Competent Authority has reviewed the Annual Declaration Report(ADR) submitted by your college/institutions and also the deficiencies pointed out by the experts. The compliance report submitted by the college has not been found to be convincing and satisfactory. **To discuss the persisting deficiencies in your College, a meeting between the Secretary of Health & Medical Education/ DME of your State and Expert Sub-Committee was convened at the Commission,** in the process for granting Annual Renewal of MBBS seats as per MSMER Regulation 2023 for the AY 2025-26.

5. As follow up action to the discussion held during aforesaid meeting, the Expert Sub-Committee recommended that State Government is to furnish an Assurance and detailed Action Plan to rectify the deficiencies flagged college-wise with respect to rectification of deficiencies of the Govt. Medical Colleges of the State.

6. On the receipt of requisite Assurance and detailed Action Plan in respect of your college, UGMEB has **decided to grant conditional renewal of 100 UG (MBBS) seats** for the AY 2025-26, **subject to rectification of deficiencies within four months from the issuance of this letter.**

7. A further review will be conducted after four months, and if the deficiencies are found to persist at that time, stringent action will be initiated as mandated under Chapter III, Clause 8 of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations (MSMER), 2023, and any other applicable rules or regulations of the NMC.

8. If the College/Institution is not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the Board, you may prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within Sixty (60) days of the issue of this letter.
